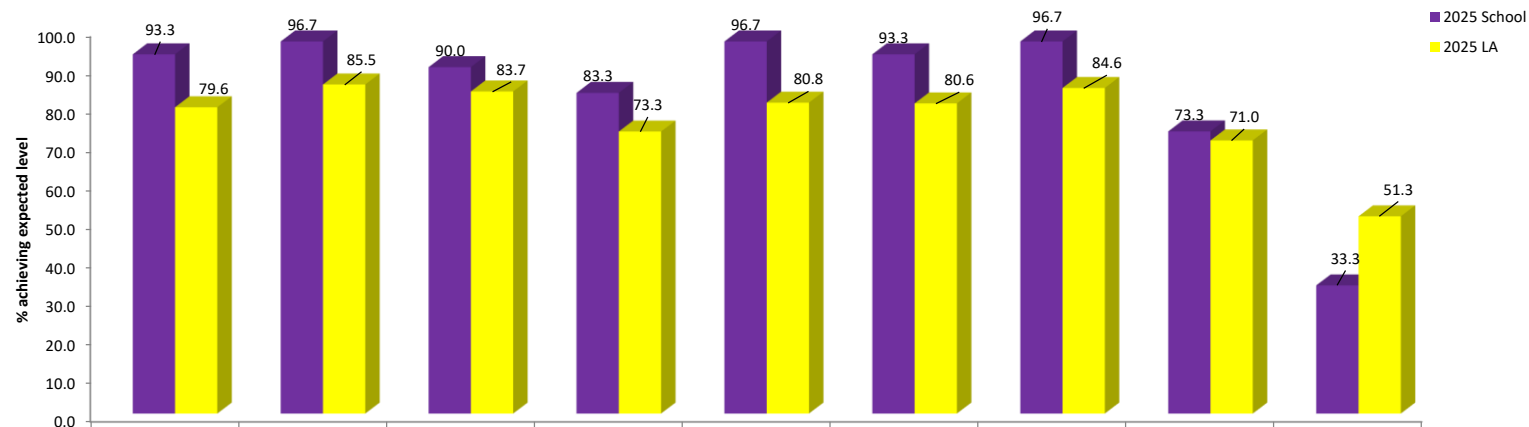

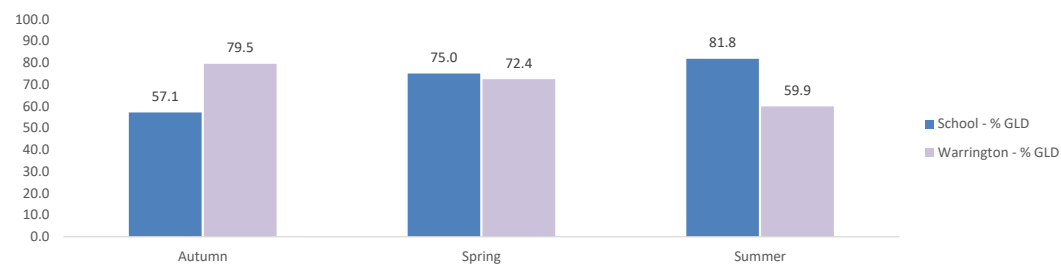

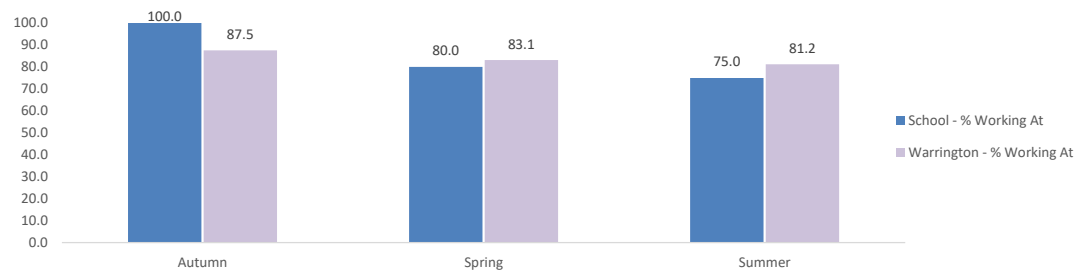

### EYFS - % GLD



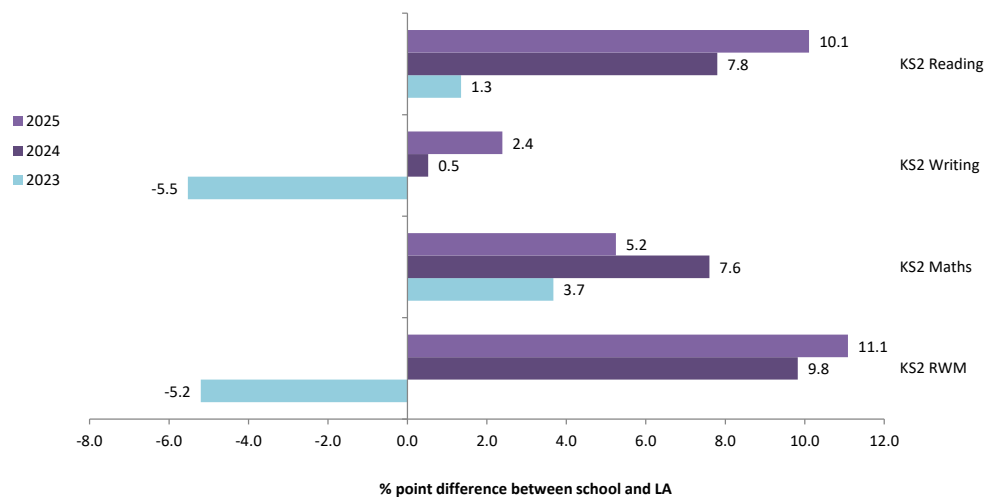
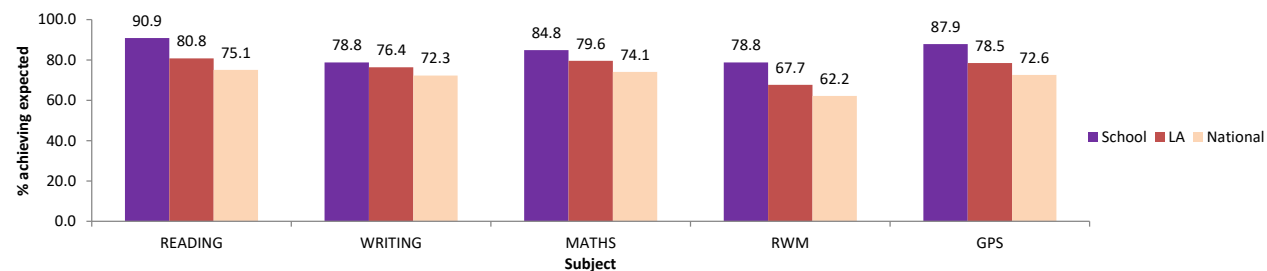

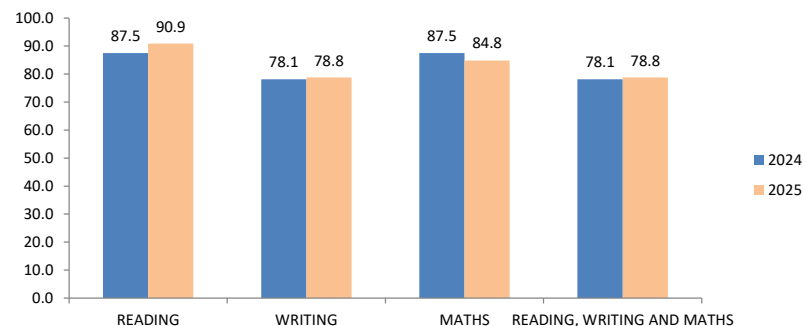

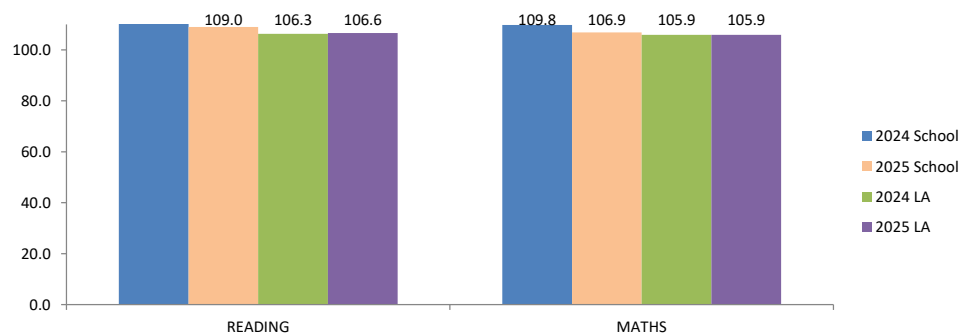

Performance compared to other schools in Warrington

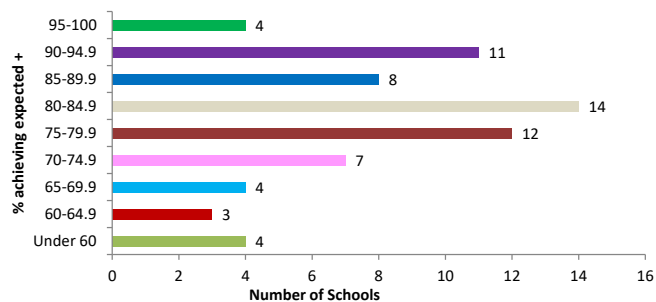
### ALL SCHOOLS - READING



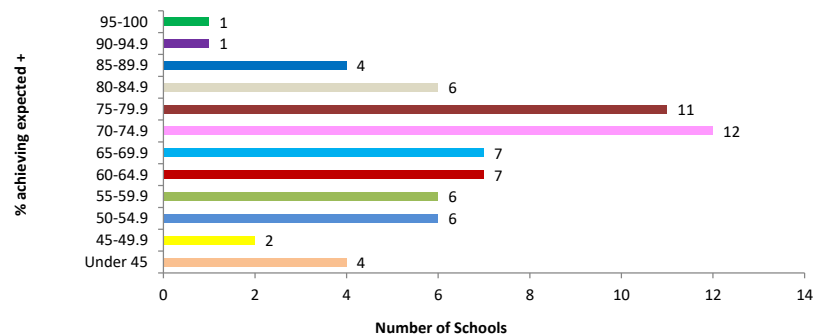
### ALL SCHOOLS - WRITING

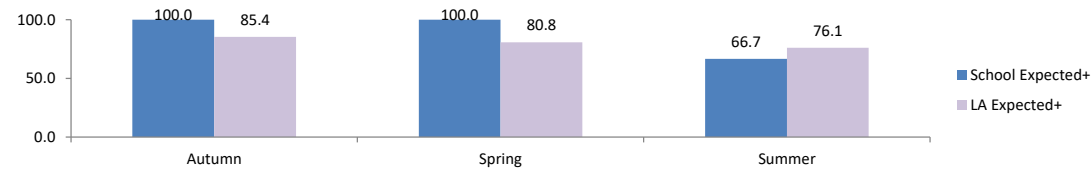

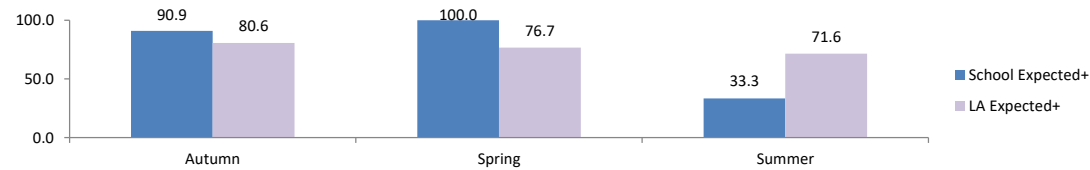

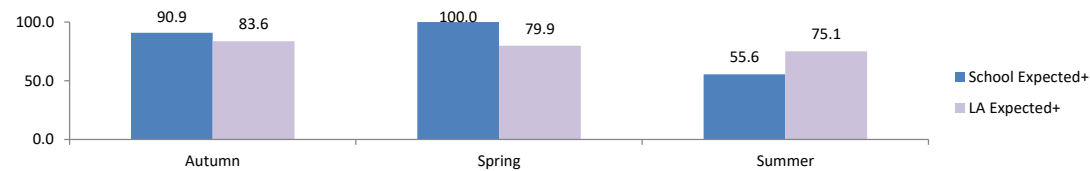
### WRITING

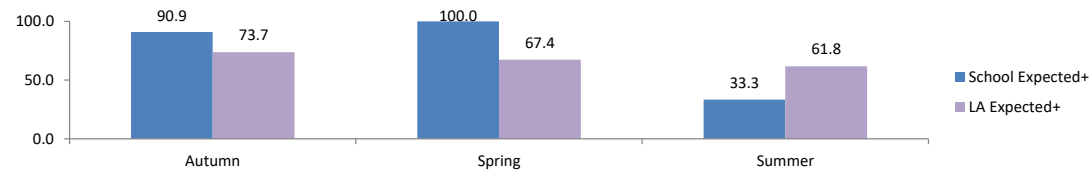
