

Dear Parents and Families,

I hope you enjoyed the dry, sunny Easter break and the chance to get together, outdoors with friends and family. The children certainly appear to be refreshed and ready to do their best in school.

School Improvement Partner Feedback

In my last newsletter, I briefly mentioned a visit we had from our School Improvement Partner, Liam Trippier who

praised our Remote Learning during lockdown. I have now received the full report from Liam and wanted to share some of the findings with you:

The return to school has been successful, pupils are calm, enthusiastic and working hard. Classrooms are presented to a good standard and displays reflect good quality remote learning and current work. Teachers and Teaching Assistants model approaches clearly and well. Reading is promoted throughout reading areas and libraries are attractively decorated. The Key Stage 2 library has a beautiful new mural. Libraries are well stocked with fiction texts and the school reading scheme.

Next Steps:

- Improve the stock on non-fiction texts
- Complete an Upper Key Stage 2 transition plan for writing.

Reading

Please encourage your children to read on a regular basis (Three or more times a week ideally).

Please record your child's reading practice at home in their 'Reading Record Book' as this is how the class teacher/TA knows that reading books need to be changed.

If there is no written comment or signature in the reading record book, we assume that the books have not been read, therefore new ones will not be issued.

We will issue three books a week to children in the youngest classes <u>if they are reading regularly</u>. We will know they have read regularly if parents have commented in the 'Reading Record'.

Dance Lesson-Year 3

Mrs Lynch and I had the pleasure of being invited to watch Class 3 perform their 'Pirate dance' on Monday. Every single child was engrossed in their atmospheric performance and managed to keep in character throughout the dance. I hope you enjoy watching the video of the children that Miss Flower posted on SeeSaw.

No Earrings in PE/Swimming Lessons

Extra-Curricular Clubs Safety Reminder

Our new club list for Summer 1 has been launched and clubs have started this week. For the safety and security of our children who attend clubs we have the following measures in place:

- School gates will be locked at 3:40pm, after children have been collected from school.

- The car park double gate will not be open, as this is not a safe pick up point at the end of the day.
- Please do not arrive to collect your child from a club before 4:30pm; the gates will be locked.
- To collect a child early due to exceptional circumstances, please come to the school office.
- Each club has a designated 'pick up point' these are on the Club Register.
- Please use our ONE WAY system and exit our site quickly as the pedestrian gates will be locked again at 4:40pm for the safety of our After School Club children.
