

Each teacher is looking forward to getting to know their new cohort of children when they move up in September. Our Senior Management Team have carefully studied each cohort of children to ascertain the needs of the individual children and the support that will be required.

The support given to each class may look uneven however, some of our classes have a higher number of children who have special educational needs and therefore are allocated more teaching assistant support. This is why we do not have one TA and teacher per class.

SEPTEMBER ARRANGEMENTS

From September, the current measures are not expected to be necessary and we will revert to how our school day was managed previously. In summary:

- Our children will not need to be in separate 'bubbles'
- Full school assemblies can resume in the hall
- Our one-way system will NOT be in operation anymore
- Start and collection times will return to normal

Start time: 8:50am for all children. Gates / doors close / registers are taken at 9am.

Classes F, 1, 2 to be collected at 3:15pm

Classes 3, 4, 5, 6 to be collected at 3:30pm

There are a couple of changes that were made last year that we are keeping regardless of Covid as they proved to be beneficial.

- 1. In September, the children will be asked to come to school in their PE kit on the two days when they have PE. The timetable for PE will be finalised and published on Thursday, 2nd September.
- 2. The children had their own individual stationery items, rather than sharing resources. This was introduced for hygiene purposes but we found this to have wider benefits than this and will continue to encourage children to have their own equipment. We have put together a pack of resources that your child will need; this pack can be purchased for £2 on ParentPay.

ALL CHILDREN SHOULD COME TO SCHOOL IN CHERRY TREE SCHOOL UNIFORM (not PE kit) on Thursday, 2nd September.
