

On behalf of our team, thank you so much for the cards and gifts that were given to staff at the end of term! Your generosity was very much appreciated.

#### **Covid Update**

As you know, businesses, hospitals and schools are experiencing significant challenges as a result of staffing shortages due to Covid-19 which is effecting continuity and provision. This means that we may need to move staff around to cover absence or book a supply if we cannot cover in-house. Our first priority continues to be face to face education in a safe environment. We are fortunate to have an experienced, dedicated and flexible staff team at Cherry Tree who tirelessly adapt to change. It is always our aim to maintain consistency and high quality education whatever the challenges we face.

This week we have 4 staff members who are off sick with Covid. In addition, the cleaning and school meals services that we buy into from Warrington Borough Council are also suffering with staff shortages.

The adaptations in place to cover these absences are as follows:

**School Meals:** Jenny our cook is absent; cover has not been possible to arrange on Thursday and Friday this week. Therefore, we are only able to offer a packed lunch not a hot meal. For those who pay for school meals you may prefer to provide your child with a packed lunch from home. We hope to return to normal service next week.

**Class F:** Mrs Baines is absent and will be covered by Mrs Bolger and Mrs Oldham. Covering a teacher absence with a familiar member of staff is particularly important for our youngest classes.

**Class 3:** Mrs Barton and Miss Flower are absent. A regular supply teacher, Mrs Forshaw, who is known to the children is covering Year 3 until Miss Flower returns.

#### After School/Breakfast Club

As of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, the After School Club/ Breakfast Club childcare provision which operates from our school hall, transferred under the management of Cherry Tree School. Most of the staff remain the same other than Sue and Yvonne who left at Christmas. Sue and Yvonne's positions are being covered by extending the hours of existing staff and with one new 'play-worker', Louisa James. Now that the transfer is complete, we are in a position to advertise for a new manager and deputy manager.

Anyone wishing to book a childcare place should do so by contacting the school office. A small number of ad hoc places are currently available; if you need temporary childcare cover, contact the office to see if we can help.
