

Welcome Back

Firstly, I would like to extend a warm welcome to our new families in Foundation Stage (Class F) and also to the new child who has joined in Year 3. I am certain our new children will settle quickly at Cherry Tree School and enjoy learning with us.

Thank you

Thank you for your kind words of support and appreciation at the end of term. The staff and I were very grateful for the cards and gifts that were given to us at the end of the last academic year. Your generosity was very much appreciated and the messages of thanks written in cards meant a great deal to us all.

New Toilet Block

Our new unisex toilet block for Class F and 1 has been completed and a new porch has been installed for Class F to enter/exit the building. This project was entirely funded by Warrington Borough Council, following an appeal from our school for 'capital funding'. There is a small amount of 'contingency' money that remains unspent so we aim to refurbish the toilets that are used by the Year 4, 5 and 6 children.

New Playground Equipment

Last year our school council worked closely with our Business Manager, Mrs Lynch and our PTA to secure funding for new play equipment. The school councillors met with various contractors to outline their requirements and to negotiate a good price.

Work has begun to install the equipment chosen by the children and should be completed next week.

New Governor

I am pleased to announce that we have a new governor who has been co-opted to our governing board-Victoria Kirkham, parent of Grace (Year 1) Finlay and Lucas (Year F) joined our governing board from 1st September. Victoria attended our staff and governor training last week and is keen to get involved in the work of the governors.

We also have a vacancy for a 'Parent Governor'. I will shortly be asking for nominations for this role, more information to follow, week commencing 19th September.

SPORTING NEWS

For those families who are new to us, our school recognises the benefit of physical activity; learning new sporting skills; being active every day and the chance to take part in intra/inter/external sporting events and competitions. This half term, Year 5 and 6 will be coached by Warrington Wolves rugby coaches for one of their PE lessons. During the course of the academic year, swimming lessons at Lymm High will take place for Year 4 (Autumn) and 5 (Spring/Summer) and Year 6 after SATs.

We also have other enrichment opportunities planned for this academic year such as Taekwondo for Years F, 1, 2, and 3 in the spring term and Cricket for all year groups in the summer term.

Our children have two lessons of PE per week, plus we have activities on offer at lunch time to keep the children active such as Sports Crew / Change for Life / Running Track.

Children are welcome to keep a spare pair of trainers in school for use on days when they do not have PE, to enable them to take part in active break times and use our running track.

On the day when children have PE, we ask them to wear their PE kit for the full day. This includes if they are going swimming; a separate letter will outline what is needed for swimming lessons.
