

Homework

Homework is an important way of helping children to develop positive learning habits, self-discipline and independent learning. It also reinforces and helps children retain information taught in the classroom. Please encourage your child to complete their homework to a high standard. The class or classes with the highest completion rate will be given a special mention in our praise assembly.

IMPORTANT: Mobile Phone Policy

We have recently had our Safeguarding Procedures reviewed by an external consultant and are taking their recommendations on board. We will be implementing some additional measures to ensure the safety of all our children and the security of the school site.

In order to safeguard all of our children, visitors are not permitted to use mobile phones, including to take photographs when in school. Some families do not consent to their child being featured in photographs on social media etc. We manage this by taking photographs of children where consent HAS been given and sharing these via 'SeeSaw' or on our website, where permission has been granted.

Visitors are asked to keep their phone switched off and in their bag/pocket whilst on the school premises. If visitors feel they may need to be contacted urgently, they are welcome to pass on the school telephone number: 01925 755885 to anyone who may need to contact them.

Attendance

Since the pandemic, school attendance has dipped nationally. As a result, new measures have been brought into place, including an attendance officer assigned to every school. Good attendance is classed as above 95%, which equates to less than ten days off school over the course of a full school year (Approx. three days off per term). Attendance that falls below this, for whatever reason (including illness), triggers a red flag when we complete the termly census.

At Cherry Tree, attendance always has been a strength and still is above national figures; However, we have also seen a decline in our overall figures since the pandemic. The number of families taking holidays during term time has also increased.

Our attendance target is 97%, which is in line with previous years. Currently, whole school attendance as of 3rd March 2023, is at 95.16%.

We are tightening up on our procedures and want to make you aware that if your child's attendance hits one of the triggers; meaning that it is becoming a concern, you will be notified using the following steps:

- 1. A message via ParentApp to alert parents that attendance has hit a trigger and is a concern
- 2. A letter to explain that attendance has not improved and is being closely monitored and the offer of support to improve the matter
- 3. If attendance has still not improved, a letter will be sent to invite parents to a meeting to discuss attendance
