

#### **Welcome Back**

A very warm 'welcome back to school' for all our families and particularly those who are new to Cherry Tree! Selecting a school for your child is a very important decision; we are pleased that you have put your faith in us and recognise that our school is the right choice for your family.

The children in all year groups have had a very positive start and we are excited about the academic year ahead.

## Thank you

Thank you for your kind words of support and appreciation at the end of the summer term, the staff and I were very grateful for the cards and gifts that were given to us. Your generosity was very much appreciated and the messages of thanks written in cards meant a great deal to us all.

#### **School Environment Improvements**

You have no doubt noticed our new entrance porch. All schools are given a small amount of ring-fenced funds that can only be spent on building projects- we have used this money to create a larger entrance area. We are grateful to St Helen's Glass who completed the work and gave us a very competitive quote as they were aware of the budget pressures that we are facing. Over time we will add displays etc. to develop the aesthetics of our porch.

Warrington Borough Council have committed to re-surfacing the parts of our playground that are damaged by tree roots. Timescales were too tight to complete this over the summer holidays but we hope this will happen soon.

#### **Health and Safety Update**

A brief reminder that the Governors and I would like to make you aware that **parts of our playground surface are uneven** and could potentially present a trip hazard. Should you require assistance in accessing our school site, please contact the school office and we would be happy to help.

#### New 'Hatch'

We have a new 'hatch' for visitors- it is a white sliding window on the left hand side of the new entrance porch. To ring for attention, our doorbell is on the window.

All parents and visitors must sign in before coming into school unless attending an assembly or parents' evening; we use a fire register or a pre-booking system for these.



# New Finish Time for Years F, 1 and 2

From September 2023 we have lengthened the school day for Class F, 1 and 2 by FIVE minutes.

Our new collection time for Class F, 1 & 2 is 3:20pm

This will reduce the waiting time for families who have children in KS1 (Infants) and KS2 (Juniors) and provide our youngest children with an extra 25 minutes in school each week.



#### **REMINDER: September Changes**

From September we have limited the afternoon sessions to preschool children only (age 3+) so that we can focus on helping the older children to be school-ready.

On a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoon a slightly more formal approach will be adopted to prepare children who are aged 3 or 4 for the transition to Foundation Stage (Class F). This means that we will not be able to accommodate

children under 3 years old within these sessions. Also from September, the sessions will be split as follows:

Morning 8:45am – 11:45am Afternoon 12:15pm – 3:15pm

Children will still be able to do both sessions and bring a packed lunch. Lunchtime for children staying for the full day will be from 11:45am – 12:15pm.

#### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Please support us in maintaining good attendance and punctuality.

School starts and <u>registration takes place at 9am</u>; we expect all children to arrive before this time.

The minimum percentage attendance we expect is 97% attendance. This means missing no more than 5 days per year.

#### **Ofsted Update**

Cherry Tree was last inspected by Ofsted 13 years ago and we were awarded an Outstanding rating. We have worked hard since then to continually improve our school.

Ofsted continues to measure our progress and I am advised they will arrive this Autumn term to assess our school. They will call me, as the Head Teacher, the day before and arrange a 2 day visit, starting at 8am the following morning. During the inspection they will expect to meet and interview staff, governors and children. Parent views will be captured via an online link, which they will provide.

I know our children and school community will be confident and upbeat when our inspectors arrive. We see this as an opportunity to show our strengths and the fantastic school community we have.

In the meantime, as always we will be continuing to work hard to make our school the best it can be.

#### **Extra-Curricular Clubs**

Our extra-curricular clubs for the Autumn Term are available to book via ParentApp. Our booking system went live on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> September at 6pm and will remain open until midnight on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September. Clubs will start the week commencing 18<sup>th</sup> September. If you have not been able to book a space on a club, please speak to the office team, not the club leaders. We operate a waiting list on a 'first come first served' basis.

During the Autumn Term we do not offer clubs to our Class F children; we allow them time for them to settle into the school routine and for our staff to get to know them before inviting them to join clubs.

#### **Reminder: School Meals Price Increase**

Please be advised that the cost of a school meal is set to rise from £2.40 to £2.60 from September 2023, resulting in an overall weekly increase of £1 per child.

# Mobile Phone Policy- a message from our Chair of Governors /Safeguarding Governor

Safeguarding our children is a top priority at Cherry Tree. We have recently been working with an expert who has reviewed our policies and procedures to ensure we have the best possible systems in place. As part of this our mobile phone policy was recently updated. The new policy, which prevents the use of mobile phones by visitors while in the school building, is now in line with national best practice. We do appreciate that many find this frustrating but are grateful for your support in adhering to this new policy to ensure the safety of all our children.
