Literacy

Books: Mick Inkpen stories

Comprehension: Talk about stories. Predict what will happen next.

Phonics: Recognise phonemes (to be shared each week). Further develop blending.

Writing: Be able to accurately form many letters. Begin to apply phonics to spelling.

Communication & Language

Look at a person when they are speaking.

Listen attentively to stories.

Use simple sentences.

Use the past tense correctly.

Physical Development

Gross motor: Spatial awareness. Balancing. Stopping and starting.

Fine motor: Hold a pencil correctly/use the tripod grip. Use scissors and paintbrushes.

Expressive Arts & Design

Art: Finger painting. Making collages. Creating Christmas cards, Christmas tree decorations, etc.

Music: Sing well-known nursery rhymes. Learn some Christmas songs (and perform them on stage!)

Science: Seasonal changes. Keeping clean (oral health, etc).

History: How toys have changed.

Geography: Our local area.

Literacy:

Read at least 3 times per week.

Check the LW home learning sheet. Practise the sounds and tricky words.

Maths:

Count objects/sing counting songs.

Practise writing the numbers 1-5.

Maths

Identifying / naming 2D shapes (circles, triangles, squares and rectangles).

Using positional language (on, under, in front of, behind, between, etc).

Finding 1 more and 1 less.

Partitioning numbers into two parts.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Self regulation: Follow school rules. Talk about feelings.

Managing self: Follow simple instructions.

Building relationships: Take turns with others.
