How You Can Help

English
Read with your child at home as often as possible.
Watch your child carefully when they are writing and check that they are forming all their letters correctly. Get them to write out lines of any letters they are struggling with.
Maths
Practise counting in 2, 5 and 10
Opportunities for your child to use coins (money) in real life contexts.
Practise telling the time O clock and half past.

Maths

Money: Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction,

Place value within 100 :Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals. 1 more and one less.

Time : Discuss the language of time, before and after and hours, minutes and seconds. Knows days of week and months of the year. Use the language to show the passage of time. Measure how long things take. Tell the time to the half hour.
